

BATTERY OPERATED INFRARED TRANSMITTER IRTXB-1

The battery operated infrared transmitter (IRTXB-1) is specifically designed to work with the **Triggersmart MCT-1**. It can be used to replace the wired infrared transmitter that is supplied in the standard kit when it is inconvenient to run a cable to the sensor. Its performance will be similar to the wired transmitter.

PRECAUTIONS

Do

1. Ensure all equipment is protected against water ingress or immersion.
2. Keep batteries away from children. If swallowed seek medical attention immediately.
3. Discard/recycle appropriately any leaking, deformed, damaged or discharged batteries with regard to the environment.
4. Prevent any leakage from batteries contacting eyes, skin or clothing. It can cause eye damage or skin irritation.

Do Not

1. Use any home-made or modified batteries or power sources.
2. Install batteries in reversed polarity (+ -) as this could cause damage to the sensor.
3. Mix new and used batteries
4. Use abrasive or solvent cleaners on this equipment. If necessary wipe clean only with a damp cloth and mild washing-up liquid.

INSTALLING THE BATTERIES - The unit is powered by 3 x AAA batteries. They are not supplied in the kit. These should be of the high powered type. To install the batteries remove the two screws on the underside and remove the top cover (fig 1). Fit the batteries **NOTING THE CORRECT POLARITY** (fig2). Replace the screws but be sure not to overtighten them.

OPERATION - The setting up of the transmitter is exactly the same as described in the MCT-1 manual with one notable exception. It does not require an external sensor cable to be connected. To operate the unit, move the ON/OFF switch to the ON position and the red LED will be illuminated. From thereon refer to the MCT-1 manual to set up the infrared system.




